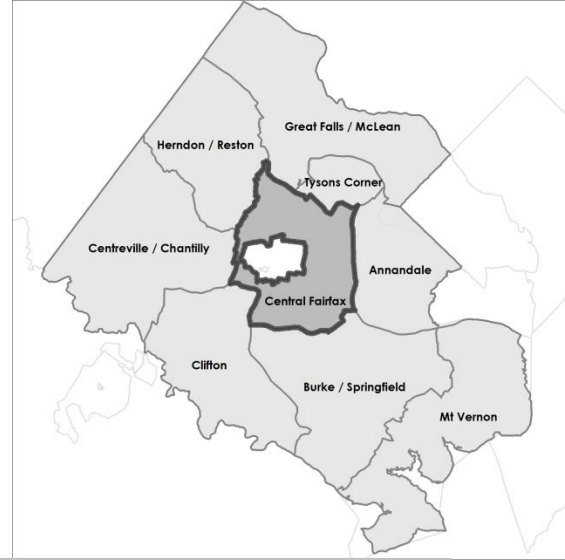
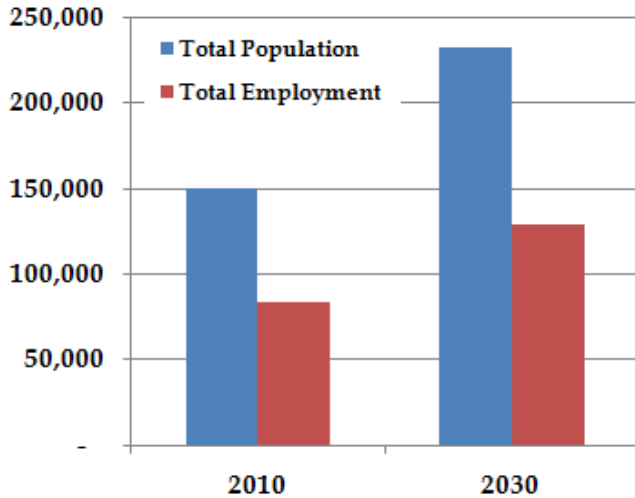


Central Fairfax Subarea Profile

Central Fairfax subarea population and employment:

- 14% of Fairfax County's population today (149,800)
- 14% of Fairfax County's employment today (83,500)
- By 2030 subarea adds over 82,600 residents and 45,800 jobs
- Forecast to be 17% of County population and 14% of County employment in 2030

According to the 2010 US Census, for workers living in Fairfax County:

- 72.1% drove alone to work
- 10.2% carpooled to work
- 8.8% took public transportation to work
- 2.3% walked to work
- 0.3% bicycled to work
- 5% worked from home
- the remainder completed by other means (motorcycle, taxi)
