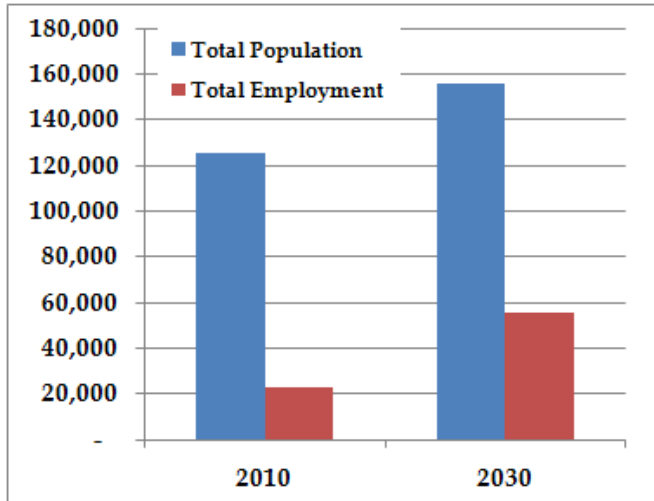

Mt. Vernon subarea population and employment:

- 12% of Fairfax County's population today (125,500)
- 3% of Fairfax County's employment today (22,600)
- By 2030 subarea adds over 30,500 residents and 33,300 jobs
- Forecast to be 11% of County population and 6% of County employment in 2030

According to the 2010 US Census, for workers living in Fairfax County:

- 72.1% drove alone to work
- 10.2% carpooled to work
- 8.8% took public transportation to work
- 2.3% walked to work
- 0.3% bicycled to work
- 5% worked from home
- the remainder completed by other means (motorcycle, taxi)
