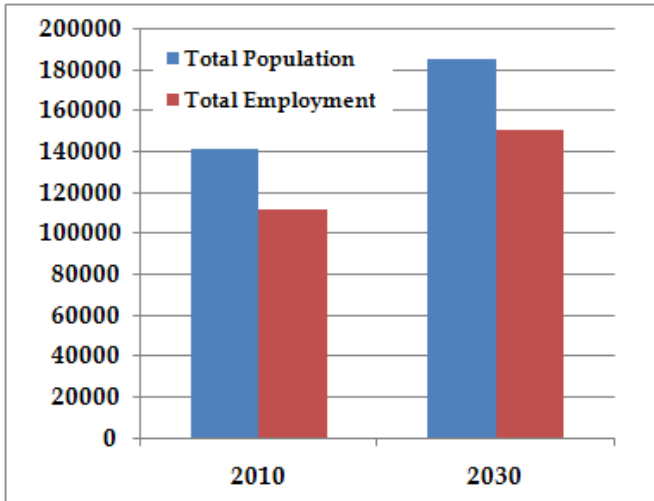

### Population and Employment



Hendon-Reston subarea population and employment:

- 12% of Fairfax County's population today (140,700)
- 18% of Fairfax County's employment today (112,000)
- By 2030 subarea adds over 44,000 residents and 38,000 jobs
- Forecast to be 13% of County population and 16% of County employment in 2030

According to the 2010 US Census, for workers living in Fairfax County:

- 72.1% drove alone to work
- 10.2% carpoled to work

- 0.3% bicycled to work
- 5% worked from home
- the remainder completed by other means (motorcycle, taxi)
